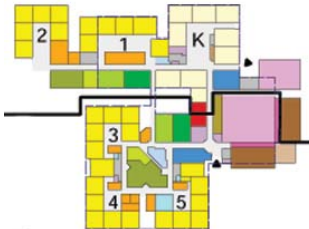


TBA's master planning work is comprehensive. It includes site selection and analysis; site acquisition and disposition; physical and financial planning and feasibility analysis; institutional design; community participation; legislative design, for both public and private sector clients; and negotiation with all levels of government. We have evaluated dozens of sites throughout New England for private industrial clients; provided physical planning for multi-hundred-acre greenfield sites to urban brownfields throughout Massachusetts; surveyed historic districts; and modified the authority and procedures for local historic commissions to facilitate reuse and redevelopment on both the East and West Coasts.

TBA has worked with Plymouth County for over 20 years beginning with initiating and master planning the \$114 million Criminal Justice Center that includes a unique privately-funded correctional facility serving county, state, and federal levels of government, an administrative headquarters and support complex for the Plymouth County Sheriff's Department, and the headquarters for the Town of Plymouth's police department. TBA also initiated the redevelopment of the Brockton Trial Court, developed by the Commonwealth under special design/ build authorization, and facilitated siting of the state's District Court in Plymouth.
